The average Public Power Customer experiences outages of LESS than 1 hour a year, barring major events.**



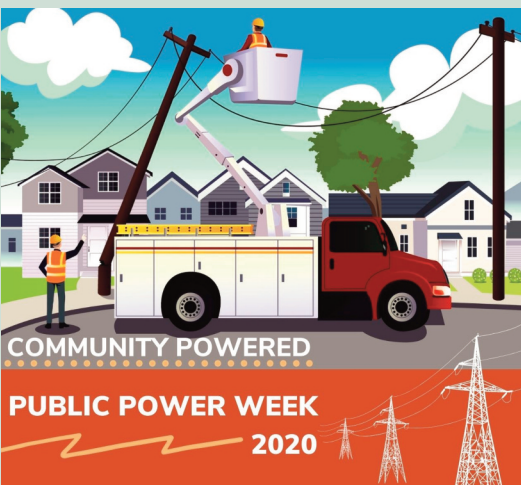
LOCAL PEOPLE FASTER SERVICE
